Instructions for Completing Guarantor Form in lieu of proper identification

1. Complete the form "Application for Certificate of Indian Status".
2. Complete the "Lost or Stolen Certificate of Indian Status Declaration Form", if previously issued status card was lost/stolen.
3. Complete the "Applicant's Declaration" section of the Guarantor form.
4. Take completed forms to an eligible Guarantor (see list below).
5. Have Guarantor complete and sign the form.
6. Have Guarantor sign the back of a photograph of applicant.
7. Bring all documents, including signed photograph, to nearest INAC office or First Nation (call in advance recommended).

List of Eligible Guarantors for Status Card Application:

- Dentist, medical doctor or chiropractor
- Judge, magistrate, police officer (municipal, provincial, RCMP)
- Lawyer
- Mayor
- Minister of religion authorized under provincial law to perform marriages
- Notary Public
- Optometrist
- Pharmacist
- Postmaster
- Principal of a primary or secondary school
- Professional Accountant
- Professional Engineer
- Senior administrator in a community college
- Senior administrator or teacher in a university
- Social Worker
- Veterinarian

Note: The Guarantor must have known the client for at least two (2) years.
