Small Business Grant Application Process

Sagamok Anishnawbek First Nation CEDO Program sets aside a portion of its administration budget for the small business grant program. The purpose of the small business grants program is to provide equity to members to enable them to establish or expand their business and to access other business financing.

Eligibility is restricted to businesses located on-reserve and the applicant must be a registered band member with the Sagamok Anishnawbek First Nation.

All Small Business Grants Applications must include the following documents to be considered a complete application and all forms and documentation must be *completed in full* to be considered a completed application:

Applicant Documents

- 1. Business plan demonstrating viability (as determined by EDO)
- 2. Proof of cash equity/bank statement
- 3. Project cost quotations
- 4. 3 years of financials which support viability for new businesses or 25% increase in revenues for existing businesses.
- 5. Updated Resume
- 6. Identification including status card and driver's license
- 7. Proof of Commercial Financing (if available)

Sagamok Anishnawbek First Nation Forms

- 8. Client Consent to the Release of Information Form
- 9. Client Data Form
- 10. Business Proposal Form/Application

*Note: depending on the nature of the request, other information may be required.

Please submit complete applications no later than 4 weeks prior to any anticipated start date for proper internal processing or assistance may not be guaranteed

Processing will not begin until all required forms and documentations are completed and received.
